



AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

BETWEEN

THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF NURSING

AND

JUNTENDO UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF NURSING

Thammasat University, Faculty of Nursing and Juntendo University, Faculty of Nursing have agreed upon promoting academic cooperation and scholarly exchange between the two institutions (hereinafter "both parties"), including the following activities:

- a) research in basic and clinical Nursing
- b) undergraduate/ graduate studies and continuing education
- c) exchange of information and materials in fields which are of interest to both parties
- d) exchange of faculty staffs and Nursing students

Implementation of exchange or other kinds of operation based on this agreement shall be dealt with between departments or faculties concerned on a case-by-case basis. A specific plan shall be worked out for each joint activity. The plan shall ensure that appropriate arrangements for working, living and maintenance expenses are made before the arrival of faculties and students to the host faculty. Both parties shall make use of various funds available to them in order to implement joint activities.

This agreement shall take effect upon the dates of signatures, be valid for a period of five years, and be automatically renewed unless requested otherwise by either party.

The agreement is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent.
