



LETTER OF INTENT BETWEEN

FACULTY OF NURSING, THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY, THAILAND And

FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES. UNIVERSITI KEBANGSAAN MALAYSIA

In order to encourage closer academic ties, the Faculty of Nursing at Thammasat University, Thailand and the Faculty of Health Sciences, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia enter into an agreement of cooperation to establish programs of exchange and collaboration in areas of interest and benefit to both institutions. This agreement will serve as a general framework for cooperation between the two universities in order:

- a. to afford opportunities for exchange of students, faculty and research staff;
- b. to establish programs that will enablestudents and university personnel to pursue study at each other's institutions and to facilitate visits by officials from each university for the purpose of studying the other's educational system in order to develop cooperative mechanisms and to expand areas of cooperation;
- c. to cover other areas of possible interest and collaboration;
- d. to make faculty and students aware of the academic programs, research institutes, and educational resources of each other's institution.
- f. to exempt exchange faculty, staff, and students of tuition and other scholastic fees incurred at the other institution.

A designated person at each institution shall oversee and facilitate the implementation of this agreement in cooperation with other appropriate administrators at the respective institution.

The scope of activities under this agreement shall be determined by the funds regularly available at both institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken and by such other financial assistance as may be obtained by either institution.

The present Letter of Intent will come into effect from the date of its signature by THE PARTIES and will remain valid for the period of 5 (five) years. Either institution wishing to terminate this Agreement shall notify the other institution in writing at least six (6) months prior to termination. Such notification shall not affect the status of the students that have already been accepted for programs initiated prior to the termination of this Agreement. Any decision to renew or renegotiate the terms of this Agreement shall be made on the basis of consultations between the two institutions.
