



AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY
FACULTY OF NURSING
AND
OSAKA CITY UNIVERSITY GRADUATE SCHOOL OF NURSING AND
SCHOOL OF NURSING
(FACULTY OF MEDICINE)

The Thammasat University Faculty of Nursing, and the Osaka City University Graduate School of Nursing and School of Nursing (Faculty of Medicine) agree to enter into a collaborative relationship for the benefit of both institutes and their respective communities by signing this agreement on February 21, 2014.

Article 1

The two institutes agree to promote activities so as to enhance each party's educational and academic roles.

Article 2

Each institute may receive some students from the other in order to promote the exchange of students as follows:

- (1) The students involved in the exchange program shall pay the academic fees, if any, at their institute of origin. The remaining expenses (travel, accommodation and the like) shall be borne by the students.
- (2) Each institute will provide students from the other institute with all the necessary support, including assistance in finding accommodation, and assist the registration of the students in order to permit access to libraries and other university facilities.
- (3) The students are required to have a health insurance policy sufficient to cover his/her own medical care during the period of residence abroad, and to show proof of this insurance.
- (4) Students will receive a Certificate of Attendance after having completed the course.

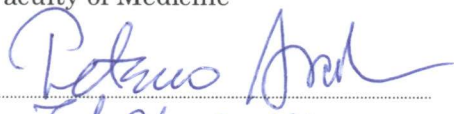
Article 3

This agreement shall take effect from the date when both signature are written, and shall be effective for a period of five years.

- (1) The agreement shall be automatically renewed for additional five-year periods unless either party provides the other with written notice that it wishes to terminate.
- (2) Notice of termination by either party must be given at least six months in advance.
- (3) This agreement may be modified by written agreement of both parties at any time.
- (4) Nothing within this agreement shall create any financial obligation or cause any hardship to both institutes.

Article 4

This agreement is to be executed in English and Japanese languages, both equally authoritative, and each party will retain a copy of the English version.
